The North Carolina Plan.

The North Carolina race war has demonstrated one thing conclusively—that elections in certain of the southern states have not been fair, as we, in this latitude, understand fair elections.

Of this feature, we do not desire to speak, because we are aware that there are more or less strong extenuating circumstances which no non-resident of the "black belt" can either fully appreciate, or properly argue.

What may be the outcome of such situations, if repeated, remains largely a matter of conjecture. Here we have a race of people, low in the social and intellectual scale, who, under the plainest of constitutional provisions, possess full rights of citizenship.

The consideration of this subject is simply "threshing old straw," and its solution, so far as this North Carolina and like sections are concerned, is likely as far off as twenty years ago.

As we said at first, the recent bold demonstration for white supremacy, which did not aim to conceal the means to the end, leaves a reasonable and logical presumption that this same power, working less openly, has, for years, decided elections in the south.

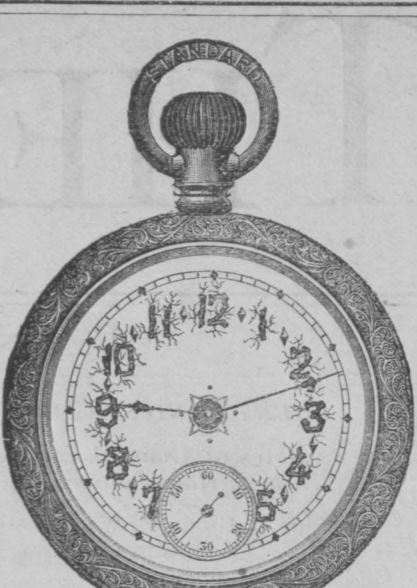
