

How Real The Revolution?
How many armed revolutionaries are there today in the towns and cities of America? It would appear that our government does not know the answer. Congressional committees, some of them with excellent investigation staffs, have been tracking down information on

the revolutionaries for the past several years—but hardly anything has been done with their findings. The few Senators and House members who evidence a frightened concern over the mobilizing revolutionary force inside America are largely ignored by the press and their colleagues.

Here is a typical poster the like of which can be found in revolutionary "pads" in "inner city" sections of most of the metropolitan areas throughout the nation: "Support and Join: PEOPLE'S ARMED DEFENSE GROUPS. Oppose the Reactionary Violence OF THE RULING CLASS. With the Revolutionary Violence of the People: PEOPLE'S ARMED DEFENSE GROUPS are being organized by THE COMMUNIST PARTY U.S.A. - MARXIST-LENIN-

IST. For further information, Write: People's Armed Defense Groups, in care of PEOPLE'S VOICE Book Store and Reading Room—9122 So. Compton Ave., Los Angeles, Calif. 90002; 2521 8th Avenue, New York City, N. Y. 10030." The "Red Guard"

Ed Montgomery, reporter on the San Francisco Examiner, infiltrated the revolutionary underground and saw some activities that the American public is most reluctant to believe: "A forerunner to a proposed nationwide Revolutionary Party, The Revolutionary Union (RU) membership is comprised of a select group of Marxist-Maoist leaders from within the underground Red Guard, the Students for a Democratic Society, The Resistance, Progressive Labor Party, and similar Communist dominated groups (such as the Black Panther Party).

"There are chapters in Palo Alto, San Francisco and Berkeley. Classes are conducted regularly in revolutionary tactics, guerrilla warfare and sabotage. Training sessions in the use of rifles, handguns and automatic weapons are held periodically in a canyon behind Half Moon Bay and in the East Bay hills. Heading up the RU is Prof. H. Bruce Franklin of Stanford, an avowed Marxist-Maoist revolutionary who co-founded the local Red Guard."

Pushing Up "The Time"
My staff and I for years have been reading the Communist press. We get the U. S. Communist publications, the Cuban Granma, the Maoist Chinese underground papers, and the various communications of Soviet Russia to their cadres of revolutionaries throughout the world. In the last six months the entire world Communist apparatus has clearly evidenced a belief that the "Time" for a revolutionary strike within America is swiftly approaching. The size of the far-flung armed revolutionary forces, and the failure of U. S. security agencies to deal with them, has excited the expectations of the Communists and their allies.

Eldridge Cleaver and his comrades in the Black Panther Party, openly working to mobilize a mammoth revolutionary army to seize control of the nation, now have an urgent slogan: "Seize the Time!" Every issue of the Black Panther newspaper carries ever more strident calls to arm. Black Panther Party officials openly claim an armed following of millions. With their weekly newspaper they are emotionally agitating all who can be reached, and its circulation is spreading throughout the "inner city" areas of the nation.

Murder Glorified
A recent issue of the newspaper carried this item: "Saturday evening, May 9, at 10:30 P. M., a pig patrolman, Bernard Bennett was shot and killed on 35th street and 4th Ave. in Sacramento." The report says that Bennett and two other police officers "chased" a group of Negroes, illegally 'demonstrating' in a Sacramento park. "The people have now come to realize that the only way to deal with the oppressor is to deal on our own terms and this was done," said the newspaper. "Around 10:30 that evening, 4 or 5 shots

rang out to find their marks lodged in the brain of a pig (Patrolman Bennett); color him dead!"

Below the report is a cartoon showing a Black Panther guerilla, holding a rifle high in his left hand, and in his right hand a bayonet on which is stuck the bleeding head of a pig. The guerilla's foot is propped arrogantly on the decapitated body of a police patrolman—the murdered "pig." In the same issue, Eldridge Cleaver says: "Black people are not in a position to face down the pigs on their level. But we are in a position

to implement head-up murder. We can guarantee the total destruction of Babylon (the U.S.) with a form of struggle that the pigs will call madness." Will the protective agencies in America permit this threatening revolutionary force to continue to expand its power and reach? They will unless millions of Americans demand that it be stamped out.

A total of 191 persons received x-rays at the Fire Hall. Due to vacation at the manufacturing plants, the Unit was unable to x-ray at those locations this year.

EIGHT MORE DIE ON STATE ROADS DURING WEEK
Eight persons were killed on Maryland highways last week, according to the survey published by the State Police. Three of those killed were drivers, two were passengers, and three were pedestrians. Alcohol was a contributing factor in one of the deaths, speed in six, and "driver error" in six.
"Three of those killed last week were pedestrians," noted Lt. Col. W. H. Conroy, Deputy Superintendent of the State Police. "In many cases it is, of course, the negligent driver who kills a pedestrian; too often, however, it is the pedestrian himself who is responsible for the accident which caused his death."
"Pedestrians, as well as drivers, have a responsibility to promote highway safety. To avoid the principal errors which cause accidents, a pedestrian should comply with all traffic control signals, staying well within crosswalk areas when so marked; not 'jay-walk'; be extremely cautious when stepping into the path of vehicular traffic

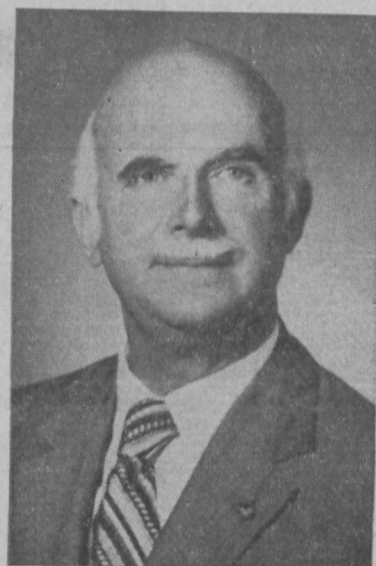
