As to the time of building the Hill church: the first one was of log; must have been built between the years 1763 and 1768, and they then gave a call to Rev. Robert Annan.

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The charge was without a regular pastor until the year 1814, when Rev. Charles G. McLean was ordained and installed as pastor of the Gettysburg and Hill churches, and so remained until the year 1842.
